3. REGISTRATION

Pre-registration: In order to support the efficient organization of the competitions, it is very important that National Federations register participants to the competitions as early as possible.

Deadline: The deadline for registration is 15 days before the first day of competition (the “Registration Date”) on **21st October 2022 at 11:59 PM UTC+0.**

Registration Fee: The registration fee is US\$30 per athlete per discipline, and it will be collected during confirmation of attendance in **cash only.**

Quota: Member Federation may register eligible five (5) competitors (for the host nation, ten (10) competitors) for each Category within the competition.

4. PRE-EVENT REGULATIONS

All athletes and team officials are recommended to have insurance coverage, covering hospitalization and all other medical coverage if required due to COVID-19 and possible repatriation back to their home country. The IFSC will not be responsible for any of these costs.

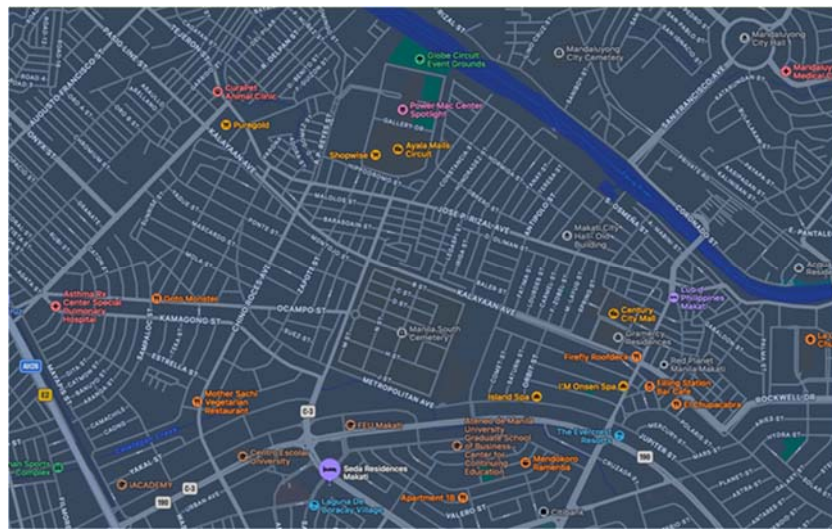

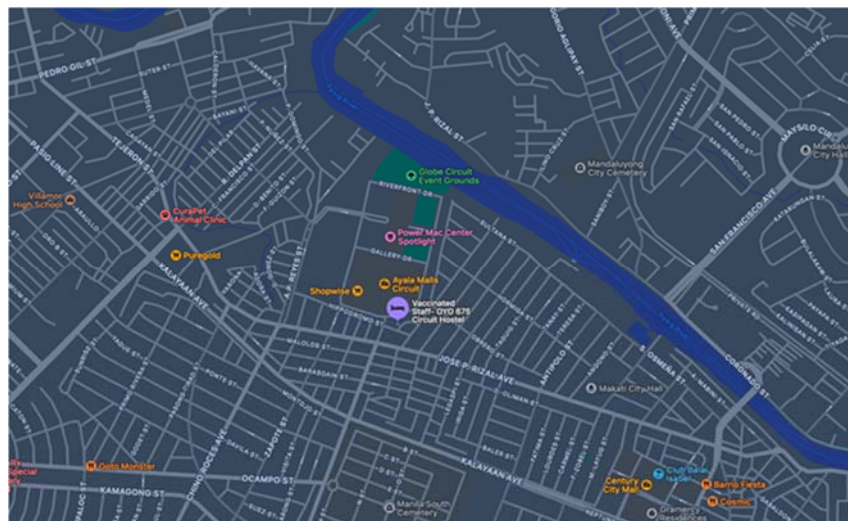

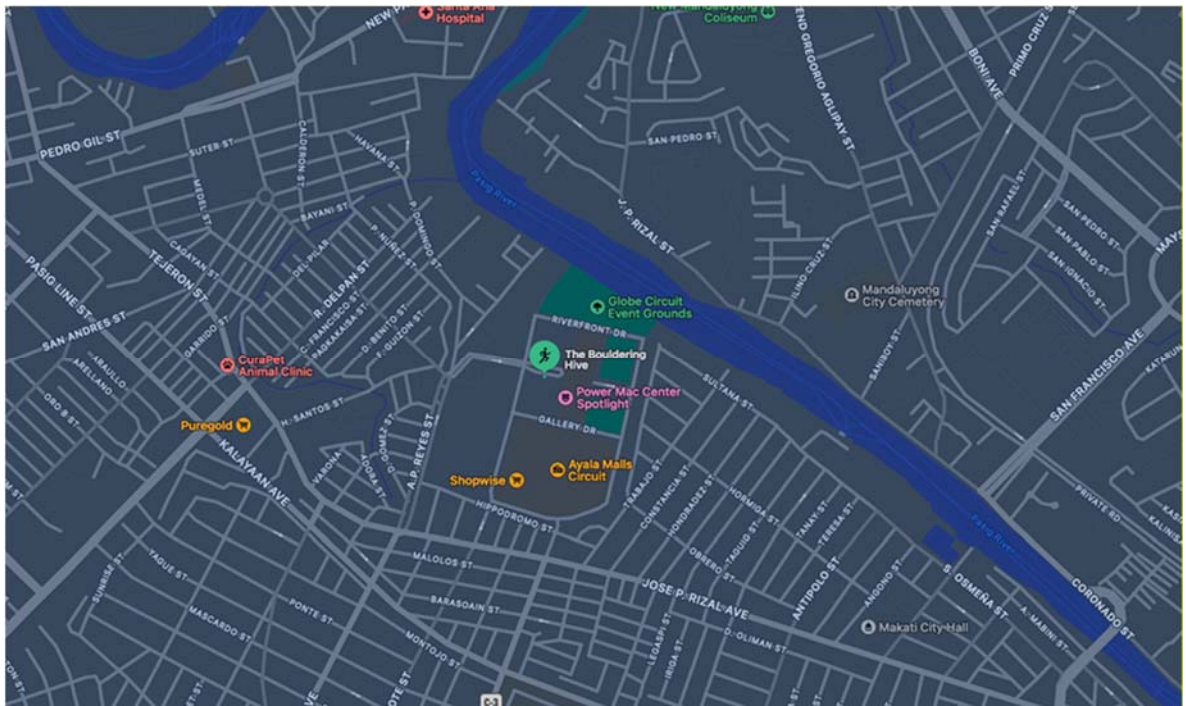

BEFORE TRAVELLING

[Travel requirements for entry to the Philippines](#)

- Fill up the details in <https://onehealthpass.com.ph/Registration/Step-1/> within 72 hours before flying.
- Fully vaccinated with booster



- No need to have a test before flying.
- Fully vaccinated without booster
 - Need to have an antigen test 24 hours before flying or RT-PCR test 48 hours before flying.
 - Minors below 18 years old who are accompanied by a fully vaccinated adult are excepted from testing.
- Not vaccinated/Partially vaccinated
 - Need to quarantine and test on arrival.

DURING THE EVENT

Please refer to the [Addendum to IFSC Rules](#) where many details are listed.

Additional measures of the organizer are as follows:

- Temperature checks of everyone daily, when entering the competition zones.
- Masks are always required at the competition venue and in public according to the Infection prevention guidelines
- Limit the risk of becoming infected:
 - Wear masks, social distancing, sanitizing shared area.
 - Stay within your team bubble.

RESPONSE PROTOCOL IN CASE OF POSITIVE TEST OR SUSPECTED CASE OF COVID-19

1.1. RESPONSE PROTOCOL IN CASE OF (SUPPOSED) POSITIVITY



The Information Sheet shall contain the protocol to follow in case a person feels unwell and/or shows symptoms of an acute respiratory infection during the event:

- The relevant Team Manager or the athletes shall inform by phone the Technical Delegate (TD);
- TD will coordinate with EO and Emergency COVID-19 Outbreak Response Coordinator Doctor on how to treat the case (treatment will depend on country to country);
- Emergency COVID-19 Outbreak Response Coordinator Doctor shall decide what to do with the other member of the team;
- The information will be published on the virtual Official Board, without the name of the person, but only the nationality.

1.2. DECISION PROCESS IN CASE OF (SUPPOSED) POSITIVITY

In case a person feels unwell and/or shows symptoms of an acute respiratory infection during the event, after having applied the protocol sub-1.3:

- TD will organize an online meeting with IFSC President, IFSC General Director, Sport Director, Jury President, Event Organiser and Emergency COVID-19 Outbreak Response Coordinator Doctor to decide if the competition shall be suspended, postponed, or cancelled.
- IFSC President has the final decision about the competition; in case IFSC President, for any reason, is not reachable, the final decision will be taken by IFSC General Director.
- TD will inform all the participants and Team Managers about the final decision and this decision will be immediately published on the Official Board and on the website.
- The management of close contact of a tested positive case will depend on the host country healthcare system and local regulations.
