

#### **KEY**

- 1. Does the New Year start in March? No, it starts in January or February.
- 2. Does it change every year?
- Yes, it changes every year (or yes, or yes it does)
- 3. What does everyone wear? They wear red clothes, (or just 'red clothes')
- 4. What do older people give to children?

Older people give lucky money to children in red envelopes (or just 'lucky money').
