





Read the following reading and answer to the questions.

Tourism is 2,000 years old. It started when rich people of the ancient Rome didn't want to stay in the city during hot summers. They took trips to the seaside and the countryside. Local people living in those areas worked for the Roman 'tourists', cooked for them or built new houses for them.

Another form of tourism became popular during the Middle Ages (1100–1500 AD). The travelers who went on this difficult journey were called pilgrims. Pilgrims were people who wanted to visit holy places. People built simple **inns** near the roads to these holy places. The pilgrims slept and ate in these inns. Many of these people had a good time during their travel, or pilgrimages.

But it was in the eighteenth century when tourism became popular. Rich people in Europe started to travel to get more familiar with different cultures. They visited seaside towns and other interesting or historical sites to rest and enjoy fresh air.

In the twentieth century a lot of Europeans got richer and wanted to travel even more. Soon there were hotels almost everywhere. In the 1960s, tourists started to travel by plane because it was cheap, fast, and comfortable. People all around the world discovered new destinations like Italy, Spain and France.

Today these countries are still popular with tourists. China and Iran in Asia, the USA in North America, and Egypt in Africa are also among the most popular holiday destinations which attract a lot of tourists.
