A dictionary is a type of book which explains the meanings of words. The words are (---16---) in alphabetical order so that they can be found quickly. The word "dictionary" comes from the Latin "dictio" ("saying"). There are several (---17---) of dictionaries: dictionaries which explain words and how they are used, dictionaries which translate words from one language to another, dictionaries of (---18---) which tell about famous people, technical dictionaries which explain the meanings of technical words or words connected to a (---19---) subject. Some of these come close to being an encyclopedia, but an encyclopedia gives a lot of extra information about things (knowledge) and does not explain the use of the language. An encyclopedic dictionary gives less information about the topic than a real encyclopedia does, but more than a (---20---) dictionary.
